Because we are **completely dependent** on the Holy Spirit for the **transformation** of our lives, we must **obey** and **submit** to the Lord in **everything**.

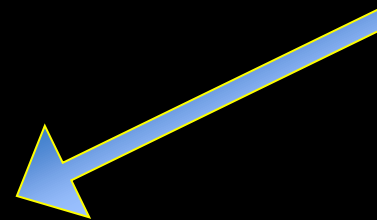
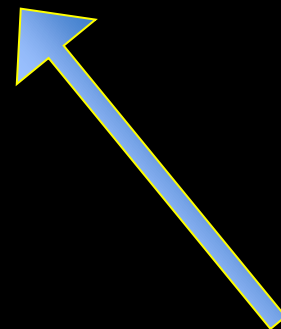
