

A generous life <u>reflects</u> the generosity of our God.


(Think "reflect HIM" not "rule to keep")






Stewardship is a "law of created design" not a law of dictatorship.

"I will make you into a great nation, and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing."




