What is the Kingdom of Heaven?

It IS:

- The sovereign rule of HEAVEN, the very nature of heaven – the presence of God, breaking through HERE ON EARTH, right here, right now.

(Matthew 6:10)

- God's plan to unite heaven with earth – made real through the person of Jesus (doing what the temple in the OT represented – the presence of God), bringing heaven and earth together.

- The rule of Jesus over all creation, redeeming and reconciling the world to himself, and putting all things to right.
