Why Church?

I Peter 2:4-10

As you come to him, the living Stone - rejected by men but chosen by God and precious to him - you also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. For in Scripture it says: "See, I lay a stone in Zion, a chosen and precious cornerstone, and the one who trusts in him will never be put to shame." Now to you who believe, this stone is precious. But to those who do not believe, "The stone the builders rejected has become the capstone." and "A stone that causes men to stumble and a rock that makes them fall."

They stumble because they disobey the message - which is also what they were destined for.

- <u>But you are</u> a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, <u>that you may</u> declare the praises of him <u>who called you</u> out of darkness into his wonderful light.
- Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received *I Peter 2:4-10*

I Peter 2:9-10

You are: a chosen people, people belonging to God Isaiah 43:20 a royal priesthood a holy nation Exodus 19:6 that you may declare the praises of Him who called you Isaiah 43:21 once not a people, now the people of God Hosea 2:23

once had not received mercy, now have received mercy

Hosea 2:23

ekklesia

"called out ones" "those who gather"

NT ekklesia refers to people who God has gathered to Himself in Christ Jesus

Church is "God's household" (I Tim. 3:15)

Why Church?

As God's family and redemptive community we are chosen and we belong we declare the praises of God we live as light in a dark world we receive mercy

Church is at the center of God's purposes "to bring all things in heaven and on earth together under one head, even Christ" Ephesians 1:10 LIVE IN LIGHT OF WHO YOU ARE a chosen people a royal priesthood a holy nation a people belonging to God called out of darkness called into his wonderful light the people of God who have received mercy
