Misplaced hope is a loss of hope waiting to happen.

Main Thought: What we hope in and long for determines how we live and grow up

What do you hope in and long for in challenging times? Really.

The hope of Jesus followers:

- 1:3 a new birth into a living hope
- 1:13 set your hope fully on grace
- 1:21 have faith and hope in God

What Jesus followers are to long for: 2:2 - crave pure spiritual milk of God's Word, so by it you may grow up

How Does Living Hope Live In Us? I Peter 1:3, 23

Our living hope arises from a new birth

The resurrection of Jesus does not produce hope until we hear about it and understand it to be true!

What is Our Part In Growing Up in Grace? I Peter 1:13; 2:1-3

3 Imperatives

- 1:13 hope fully on (object of hope)
 - 2:1 purity (moral effect of hope)
 - 2:2 crave (nourishment of hope)

By grace,

we chose God and His promises as the object of our hope.

We rid ourselves of vices which is the moral effect of hope.

We crave or long for the pure spiritual milk of God's Word which nourishes our hope

What Are Results of Growing Up in Grace? I Peter 2:4-5; 9-10

Three Outcomes:

- 2:4 long to be with Jesus (the Living Stone)
- 2:5 being built into a spiritual house (as living stones)
- 2:9-10 have a new identity/purpose (as the people of God)

What you hope in and long for determines how you live and grow up

Long for or crave (appetite for) the nourishment of God's Word

While placing your hope fully in who God is and what He promises
