"for the Lord's sake" (2:13) "as to the Lord" (Eph. 5:22)

- a. Submit to God (James 4:7)
- b. Submit to one another (Eph. 5:21)
- c. Submission has limits (Acts 4:18-20)

"showing proper respect" (2:17)
"with respect" (2:18; 3:7)

4. Motivation for Submission the enabling work of the Holy Spirit (Eph. 5:18-21)

5. Meditation of Submission

6. Model of Submission Submit like Jesus (2:21)
