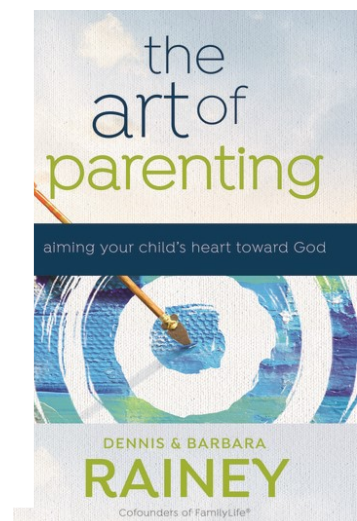


MAXIMIZE: MARRIAGEMATTERS

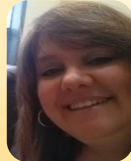

We are launching our Thursday night Breakout which is replacing Awana starting September 20th!

Why? Over the years our kids have experienced an opportunity to go deeper with their faith by being part of our program. However, almost all of our kids were in different stages of their books. This made it difficult for our leaders to give everyone full attention to help them in their scripture memorization. It also was apparent that most of the kids' drive was only for awards and not truly growing in God's Word and their faith. For these reasons we felt it was time for a new direction for CrossPoint Kids.

Breakout was written by *Craig & Mary Jutila* for (Rick Warren) Saddleback Church in California. Craig Jutila was our speaker this year for our "Faith and the Modern Family" Conference. His curriculum is now used by hundreds of churches across the country. It is a great midweek option for kids who want to be discipled in a small group setting and go deeper in their faith. Our Pre-k thru 2nd graders will go through an age appropriate series called Kids Quest. Our 3rd-6th graders will go through a four book series called Breakout. Both series are fantastic and best of all every one of us will be going through the same lesson and same scripture memory verse together in our

classes. This will allow for better communication and lots of time for small group discussion. This series also will allow us to open up our kids to experience some of our local outreaches here in Lewiston and Clarkston. Our 6th graders will have an opportunity to go on their first mission's trip to Lame Deer, Montana from July 7-15, 2019. We will still have themed nights, CO2 dragster races, and special events that will help round out our nights.
