

Small Group Questions for May 21, 2017

E:38 - How your story and God's story come together.

Isaiah 6: 1-11 - How to have hope in a world of Hurt?

Opening Questions: What in life right now is your greatest source of pleasure? And why? And if you are willing to share, what is your greatest source of pressure?

1. Discuss the following concept: Isaiah was in a time with personal, spiritual and political endings, and endings can affect, often in negative ways. They take us into what is called, 'No Mans Land.' How do you handle endings in life and what Truths of Scriptures help you navigate life's difficult transitions?
2. God gave Isaiah a great view of who he was as Isaiah's God. Tozer said our view of God is the most important thing about us. As a group, discuss how your view of God has changed through this sermon series, and what Questions about God you still have?
3. God gave Isaiah a vision of the future, and was a mix of struggle, but most of all it was a vision of a good future brought to the nation of Israel because God was going to keep his promise to his people. How important is living life with the knowledge that you have a secure future because of God's promises.
4. What are some practical ways you can be a person of hope in this world full of hurt based on Isaiah's vision of God, the Future and our Amazing Savior?
