### Reality 1 We are all building a life.

"To be human is to be on a quest. To live is to be embarked on a kind of unconscious journey toward a destination of your dreams. As Blaise Pascal put it in his famous wager: "You have to wager. It is not up to you, you are already committed." You can't not bet your life on something. You can't not be headed somewhere. We live leaning forward, bent on arriving at the place we long for. The place we unconsciously strive toward is what ancient philosophers of habit called our telos — our goal, our end.

But the telos we live toward is not something that we primarily know or believe or think about; rather, our telos is what we want, what we long for, what we crave. It is less an ideal that we have ideas about and more a vision of "the good life" that we desire. It is a picture of flourishing that we imagine in a visceral, often - unarticulated way — a vague yet attractive sense of where we think true happiness is found." James Smith

#### Similarities

#### **Differences**

Wise - φρόνιμος smart, thoughtful, prudent, enlightened Foolish - μωρός "moron" or stupid, obstinate, rebel, fool, unenlightened

2. Hears and does (practices) and the other hears and does not do (does not practice) the teachings of Jesus.

Hear - ἀκούω – to pay attention to, listen, to learn, to gain knowledge Does - ποιέω – do, keep, carry out, practice, commit, obey

3. One house *stood* and one house *fell* after the storm.

At what point are we able to tell the difference between the builders?

### Reality 3 Storms reveal the foundation of your life.

True discipleship means "learner or apprentice." To apprentice under Jesus means to learn, embody, and practice his way of life.

(John 14:12 ESV)

What good is it, my brothers, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can that faith save him?
