Post-modern thought:

- discover what truth is best for me
- moving from objectivity to subjectivity
- moving from authority to autonomy
- moving from evidence to experience

Post-Christian opposition:

- The "Christian" voice in our culture has moved from the majority and is now a minority.
- Followers of Jesus are a minority.
- Once respected, now followers of Jesus are disrespected.
- Followers of Jesus are moving from "what is right with society" to being "what is wrong" with society.

Four oppositions toward Jesus in our cultural moment:

- 1 Spiritual opposition
- 2 Post-modern opposition
- 3 Post-Christian (secular) opposition
- 4 Personal opposition

Personal opposition:

- Fear of being rejected.
- Fear of your hurting your reputation.
- Fear of losing relationships.
- I'm not sure how to actually help anyone find Jesus.


How do we handle the opposition?
